

Faculty Sabbatical Funding Resources

Notes from the October 2013 ADVANCE Mentoring-for-Leadership Lunch:

General Advice:

- Definitely take sabbatical when you are eligible.
- It can be done with kids – plan a least year ahead.
- Be mindful of the emotional and logistical space it takes to transition into and out of sabbatical.
- Local-based sabbaticals are still worth it.
- Network and socialize while you are there.
- Childcare norms different from place to place. Do your research.
- Easiest to go places where you have a connection.
- You don't have to optimize each sabbatical, you will get another one.
- The right sabbatical is a very personal choice.
- Use sabbatical as a time to recharge.
- Highly unlikely to get all the things on your to do list done.
